Academic Year (9 months)

Tuition, Fees and Books <i>(academic year)</i> (This is based on the legal requirement that you must be a full-time student with 12 credits in the fall and spring semesters.)	\$8,869
Health and Medical Insurance (All international students are required to participate in a comprehensive health insurance plan. It is a basic policy that covers you if you are sick or if you need emergency medical care. If you have health insurance from another source, you can waive this fee by showing proof.)	\$866
Monthly Rent <i>(\$650 x 9)</i> (Assumes you are sharing an apartment with other students.)	\$5,850
Monthly Utilities <i>(\$75 x 9)</i> (Includes heat, electricity and phone. Heating costs in winter may be higher.)	\$675
Food and Recreation Allowance <i>(\$290 x 9)</i>	\$2,610
Transportation <i>(\$70 x 9)</i> (For monthly T-pass or gas for cars. BHCC parking permits are an additional \$60 per academic year.)	\$630
