

Summary of Study Abroad Scholarships

- Funded by the Student Government Association and BHCC.
- BHCC scholarship pays for 80% of total expenses, students pay for 20% of total expenses.
- Most study abroad programs are from two to seven weeks in summer 2012.
- Upon completion of courses, students can obtain three-to-eight academic credits.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- You must be enrolled in a BHCC degree or certificate program for the fall 2011 and spring 2012 semesters, either part time or full time.
- You must have completed 12 or more college-level credits at BHCC by December 31, 2011.
- You must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher through the end of spring 2012 semester in all college-level courses.

Highlights of current study abroad opportunities

Argentina

- Study intensive Spanish in Buenos Aires
- Live with an Argentinean family
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn three credits in Conversational Spanish, and three credits for an additional course

Dates: 4 weeks in June or July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,100

Canada

- Study intensive French and Quebec culture
- Live with a French-speaking family in Chicoutimi
- Participate in cultural weekend excursions
- Earn four credits in Conversational French

Dates: 3 weeks in July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,300

Costa Rica

- Study biological field techniques with BHCC faculty
- Live in camp-style dormitories
- Learn about the remarkable biodiversity at the Costa Rican rainforest
- Participate in guided field excursions and practice Spanish
- Earn three or four credits in Environmental Science

Dates: 12 days in May
Approximate cost to you: \$600

Czech Republic

- Take courses in English on Czech culture, history and politics at Anglo-American College in Prague
- Live in local apartments with other students
- Participate in field trips to cultural and tourist sites in Prague
- Earn six credits in liberal arts

Dates: 4 weeks in early June to late July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,350

Denmark

- Study a wide range of academically challenging courses in Copenhagen
- Choose between living in residence halls or with other students near the center of the city
- Take part in a week-long study tour in Denmark, Sweden or Belgium
- Earn three credits in international business and economics, humanities or social sciences

Dates: 3 weeks in May to June
Approximate cost to you: \$1,200

Dominican Republic

- Study intensive Spanish in Santo Domingo
- Live with a Dominican family
- Take courses in Caribbean Culture and Spanish language
- Earn three or four credits in Conversational Spanish or Spanish Culture

Dates: 4 weeks in May to July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,100

Ecuador

- Earn eight academic credits in intensive Spanish in Guayaquil from elementary to advanced level
- Stay with Ecuadorian family
- Participate in excursions to cultural and tourist sites

Dates: 4 weeks in July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,050

England

- Study British culture at Kingston University in Kingston, England
- Take courses in theater, history and psychology
- Live in single rooms in dormitories with shared kitchen
- Earn six credits in liberal arts

Dates: 4 weeks in early June to early July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,450

France

- Study intensive French at the Institute Français des Alpes in southeastern France
- Live with a French family
- Participate in optional excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Conversational French

Dates: 4 weeks in June or July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,250

Ireland

- Study Irish culture or Irish language in Galway
- Live in apartments, in the on-campus student village or in home-stays with Irish families
- Earn six credits
- Requires 3.0 or higher GPA

Dates: 4 weeks in June or July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,350

Italy

- Study intensive Italian in Venice
- Live in furnished apartments or residential hotels
- Participate in weekend excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Conversational Italian

Dates: 4 weeks, early June to early July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,100

Japan

- Study intensive Japanese in Tokyo
- Live with Japanese family or in a dormitory
- Participate in historical and cultural excursions
- Earn at least six credits in Japanese

Dates: late June - mid August
Approximate cost to you: \$1,700

Morocco

- Study Arabic Language at Al Akhawayn University
- Live in spacious, on-campus residence halls
- Earn four credits in Arabic

Dates: 4 weeks in June or July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,250

Namibia

- Study Tourism and Natural Resource Management in Namibia or International Business and Management with focus on Namibia.
- Live on campus at Polytechnic of Namibia in Windhoek or off campus in quiet residential area
- Earn up to six credits in International Business and Management or through Environmental Experiential Learning

Dates: 4 weeks late June - mid July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,800

People's Republic of China

- Study intensive Mandarin and business in Shanghai
- Live in a foreign student dormitory at Chinghai University with an optional weekend homestay
- Participate in weekend excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Chinese, Business or Chinese Culture

Dates: 4 weeks in mid June to mid July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,100

Peru

- Study Spanish at Universidad San Ignacio de Loyola in Cusco or receive instruction in English in Inca Architecture, Art and Design in Cusco, History of the Inca Civilization, Contemporary Society of Culture in Peru, Biodiversity of Peru, and Photography.
- Live in shared, furnished apartments
- Earn six credits

Dates: End of May-July 1 or first week of July-mid August
Approximate cost to you: \$1,150

Spain

- Study intensive Spanish in Seville
- Take Culture and Society of Spain, taught in English
- Live with a Spanish family
- Participate in weekend excursions to cultural and tourist sites
- Earn six credits in Conversational Spanish and Spanish Culture

Dates: 4 weeks, mid-June to mid-July
Approximate cost to you: \$1,300
