*All **three requirements** must be met for the articulated credits in the college's Principles of Patient Care course.

**Credits will be granted only if a student is within 3 months of the completion of their program, or currently working in the CNA field.

Students who have fulfilled the learning competencies/outcome objectives as identified by their high school transcript are recommended as being competent in these subject matters and can be recognized for a total of seven **(7) credits** at Bunker Hill Community College as outlined above.

Applicants for credit must meet all the admission requirements of the postsecondary College/Institute and be an enrolled/registered student in good standing (with the College/Institute) in this program before credit is awarded.
