Effective Agreement Date: January 7, 2010

The Purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to develop a learning continuum that will enable students of Year Up Boston to progress to other educational opportunities at Bunker Hill Community College, for either a Certificate or Associate Degree and on to a four year baccalaureate program should they so choose. Courses for articulated credit in this agreement include the following:

- Those offered on-site at Year-Up Boston under the auspices of Cambridge College
- Those offered on-site at Year-Up Boston in the local Cisco Systems Academy of Bunker Hill Community College

1.0 Stage One

Year Up Boston and Bunker Hill Community College will form a collaboration which will incorporate specific activities to increase and enhance the College connection for all Year-Up Boston students. These activities include the following which may be documented in each student's file:

1.1 College Readiness activities may include: (check those that apply)

- Field trip(s) to Bunker Hill Community College
- Career Exploration Activities & Workshops
- Visits by Bunker Hill Community College Professors to Year Up Classes
- Gender Equity Workshop(s)
- ACCUPLACER CPT Preparation & Testing
- Information Dissemination on Admission and Program Requirements by the Bunker Hill Community College Admission Office and Department Chair

2.0 Stage Two

Students who have fulfilled the learning competencies/outcome objectives as identified by their Cambridge College Transcript and/or Cisco Systems Certificate of Completion are recommended as being competent in these subject matters and can be recognized for a total of twelve (12) transfer credits at Bunker Hill Community College as outlined above.

Applicants for credit must meet all the admission requirements of Bunker Hill Community College and be an enrolled/registered student before credit is awarded.

3.0 Terms for Terminating this Agreement: This agreement is for an indefinite period of time; however, a biennial Spring review shall be conducted to assess the current status of the agreement and to make recommendations for modification as necessary. This review committee shall consist of the following persons:

- 3.1 Year Up Boston Managers & Instructors
- 3.2 Academic Dean of Professional Studies of Bunker Hill Community College
- 3.3 Computer Information Technology Department Chairperson and/or designated faculty.


This agreement, mutually agreed upon by the representatives of the College and Year Up Boston, may be terminated at any time by either party with sixty (60) days prior notice.
